Preface

The *Substance Abuse Treatment & Recovery Services System Profile* is intended to **identify** those resources available in the community to address the needs of persons experiencing or at risk of developing substance use problems. This is part of a broad effort by the *Greater New Orleans Drug Demand Reduction Coalition* to address substance use problems in the community, which includes assessing the structure and capacity of treatment and recovery services currently available.

The Profile seeks to match the different services being provided to the components of the Coalition-developed service system model and, to a limited extent, assess the adequacy of the existing resources. An outline of the Service System Model is provided as part of the Profile and a more detailed description of system components is provided below. At this time, however, the Profile does not address capacity issues, includes no information on levels of service delivery, and provide very little information on the populations being served.

As currently formatted, the Profile is appropriate for planning and system assessment, but not for use by the general public. However, the information it provides could be incorporated into an everyday tool for matching patients to resources.

The Profile was developed principally from the Behavioral Health Resource Guide (BHRG) published annually by the New Orleans Health Department beginning in 2012. Other sources include: the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Facility Finder based on the annual National Survey of Substance Abuse Treatment Services (N-SSATS); a contracted provider list from the Metropolitan Human Services District (MHSD); a provider panel list from Magellan (the single managed behavioral healthcare organization serving Medicaid enrollees in Louisiana); and list from ViaLink 2-1-1 serving Greater New Orleans.

Because of the limitations of information systems and data collection, the match of model service components to the actual services available is not complete. Further no consistent information is availability regarding the capacity of the system in terms of individuals served or the quantity of services provided. In 2013 the Coalition's Treatment Work Group attempted to collect data co-incident with the annual N-SSATS survey, but with little success. Subsequent efforts by the Treatment Work Group collected a limited number of data items from the principal substance use treatment providers in Orleans Parish. This Profile attempts to be inclusive of all intervention, treatment and recovery services offered to persons with substance use problems (including former mental health providers that may be now be offering substance abuse services) but, absent state licensure, it is not known whether any facility listed as providing treatment meets the minimum requirements for quality care.

The data base underlying the Profile is an Excel spreadsheet file expanded from the 2012 Behavioral Health Resource Guide (BHRG) spreadsheet. The Excel file was updated based on

the published 2013 BHRG (for those agencies that appeared to possibly be providing services to persons with substance use problems). A copy of the published 2013 BHRG as well as the Profile data base can be obtained at

Facility

The Profile is based on a *facility* concept consistent with the N-SSATS definition. A facility is a physical location where a client *accesses* services, initially or on a continuing basis. An agency may provide multiple types of services a single facility location, but if services are provided at multiple locations, these locations should generally be considered separate facilities. Each row of the Excel spread sheet represents a facility. Where possible each facility is given its actual N-SSATS facility number; otherwise an alternate facility number is assigned.

Facilities may have multiple names. Names may have been changed and/or corporate structure or ownership may have changes.

Major Service Categories

The Profile organizes services into five major categories, each of which includes a number of different types of services. A table is constructed for each major category which identifies facilities providing services within the category:

- A. Intervention Services including Crisis Response, Street Outreach, Screening and Brief Intervention (SBI), Emergency Room SBI, Initial Assessment, Recovery Management and DWI/DUI Education
- B. Withdrawal Management & Stabilization including Medically Managed (Hospital-based), Medically Supported (Residential or Inpatient), Medically Monitored (Residential), Outpatient Withdrawal, and Outpatient Opiate Withdrawal
- C. Outpatient Treatment including Outpatient (non-intensive), Opiate Treatment Services (OTS), Outpatient Intensive, and Partial Hospitalization (Day Rehabilitation)
- D. Inpatient and Residential Treatment including Community Residence, Long-term Residential Treatment, and Short-term Inpatient or Residential
- E. Housing and Recovery Support Services including Shelter, Supportive Housing, Self-help Groups, and other Recovery Support Services

Prevention services are not included in the Profile at this time. Substance abuse prevention services funded by the Louisiana Office of Behavioral Health are described in *Prevention Services SFY 2013 Process Outcome Report*. Criminal Justice-related intervention services, other than DWI/DUI education programs, are not included in the profile. These services are typically operated directly by, or under contract with, criminal justice agencies. These services include: Diversion, Drug Court, Re-entry services and family services provided as part of Child Protective Services or Families in Need of Services (FINS) in cases of status offences or juvenile delinquency.

Telephone Hot Lines are not included in the Profile. An extensive list of hot lines is included in the 2013 Behavioral Health Resource Guide.

The service categories and types described in this Profile are consistent with the Louisiana’s Office of Behavioral Health’s licensing categories for addiction facilities and with the American Society of Addiction Medicine’s levels of care¹ as well as the categories used by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration for the National Survey of Substance Abuse Treatment Services (N-SSATS). However, certain categories have been collapsed (or expanded) and category labels may be slightly different.

Determining What Types of Service Are Provided

The principal source for determining what services a facility is providing is the services description text included in the Behavioral Health Resource Guide. In some cases, the text includes terms that are well-defined, such as, “intensive outpatient” which is a specific level of care recognized in the addictions treatment field. In other cases, the service descriptions are vague relative to the service definitions provided in this Profile. Typically, the service description includes more than one type of service. It may be difficult to determine what service is provided at what location or whether a particular service is provided for substance abuse clients.

The Behavioral Health Resource Guide categorizes agencies as mental health only, mental health and substance abuse, and substance abuse only. In a number of cases, agencies that are categorized in the BHRG as both mental health and substance abuse, when contacted, indicated that they did not provide substance abuse treatment. In a few cases a mental health only agency indicated that substance abuse services were being provided, but this may only be for clients already admitted for mental health treatment. The mental health and addictions fields are each complex in terms of the presenting problems, populations served, service models and policy issues faced. Combining these fields under the behavioral health rubric will likely achieve greater efficiency, access and quality of care. However, ***the proposed practical criteria for inclusion of a service in this Profile is that: a person can access the service for purpose of preventing, treating or recovering from a substance use problem.***

Residential treatment services include short-term, long-term and community residential services. In the case of community residential services, clients may be receiving concurrent outpatient treatment services. But, all these services should be operating in a manner consistent with state and federal regulations for substance abuse services. Services description for some agencies in the BHRG indicate that they provide residential service and treatment or counseling for substance abuse. It is not always clear whether such facilities should be considered residential treatment programs or housing programs with supportive services.

A. Intervention	
Crisis Response (Mobile)	On site intervention for persons in distress due to a mental health or substance use problem, often as an alternative to arrest by a police agency.
Street Outreach	Active patrol of selected neighborhoods or venues for purposes of intervening with individuals who may have substance use and related problems. These services typically take a public health approach to reduce harm while offering intervention and referral when accepted.
Screening and Brief Intervention (SBI)	<p><i>Screening</i> – A standard protocol administered as part of an intake process to all individuals to determine whether an individual may have substance use issues affecting an agency’s or practitioner’s work with the individual. Screening may be administered in various settings including health care, criminal justice, employment and education.</p> <p><i>Brief Intervention</i> – A standard protocol administered to individuals who have screened positive for substance use issues for purposes of helping the individual reduce or cease problem use and to make referrals to treatment when appropriate. Together these components constitute a <i>Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT)</i> program.</p> <p>SBI services may be offered as part of school-based health care or <i>indicated prevention</i> programs</p>
Emergency Room Intervention (SBIRT)	Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment adapted to the hospital emergency department environment. This protocol is targeted to all emergency room patients, not just patients presenting with substance use problems.
Initial Assessment	This clinical service is provided by an appropriately licensed or credentialed professional to evaluate an individual’s substance use problems, establish a diagnosis or diagnostic impression, and make an initial level of care determination. This service may be provided in a treatment program (§7401(A)(a); §7439(A)(3)) or non-treatment setting.
Recovery Care Management	Recovery Care Management is provided to individuals who have had a substance use problem and are engaged, or wish to engage, in a recovery process. This service assists the participant in obtaining treatment, recovery support or other services and includes regular follow-up with the participant. Recovery Care Management may be provided before during or after treatment, and may be provided to individuals who do not want to or do not need to enter treatment. This service may be provided in a treatment program (SS7401(A)(b, i)) or non-treatment setting.
DWI/DUI Educational Services	Educational services required by the Court to be completed by persons convicted of driving under the influence who do not have a substance use disorder requiring treatment.
Criminal Justice Diversion	Under the auspices of the district attorney, court or probation services, diversion services provide an alternative to prosecution for individuals whose criminal offense is related to their substance use. Services involve case management and are typically coordinated with addiction treatment services.
Drug Treatment Court	Under the auspices of a judge of the court, charges and or sentences are reduced or dropped based on successful completion of the drug court program which includes participation in treatment services.

Incarceration Re-entry	This service (a) identifies inmates soon to be released from jail or prison who have had an alcohol or drug use problem that is likely to interfere with their successful re-entry, (b) provides services addressing substance use problems as well as other re-entry service while the individual is incarcerated; (c) arranges for post-release addiction treatment services; (d) provides parole supervision and monitoring of treatment participation post release.
CPS Family Support Services	Under the auspices of <i>Child Protective Services</i> (CPS), parents or guardians involved in child maltreatment (abuse or neglect) cases are provided support services including referral to addiction treatment services under the supervision and monitoring of CPS.
B. Withdrawal Management and Stabilization (Detox)	
Medically Managed Detoxification	Hospital-based acute care for intoxication and withdrawal conditions, especially in the presence of complications or co-morbidities.
Medically Supported Inpatient/ Residential Detoxification	Medically Supported. Professional medical and nursing coverage available as determined by the needs of clients admitted for detoxification in a non-hospital residential setting. (§7447(A.1.))
Non-medical Inpatient/ Residential Detoxification	Non-medical. Semi-skilled observation, monitoring and treatment by trained para-professionals, for those clients who have been medically approved, and whose detoxification process can be predicted. (§7447(A.2.))
Outpatient Detoxification	Medically-supported management for non-acute withdrawal symptoms.
Outpatient Opiate Withdrawal	Medically-supported withdrawal management provided by programs offering opiate treatment services (OTS), including methadone and buprenorphine maintenance.
C. Outpatient Treatment	
Outpatient (non-intensive)	§7439(A) Programs provide non-residential treatment services for clients who require on-going support on a regular or irregular basis, such as: 1. Continuing Care for those who have completed primary treatment and require minimal support to avoid relapse; 2. Early Intervention for those who have been identified as substance abusers and referred for education, activities, or support services designed to prevent progression of disease; 3. Initial point of entry/reentry. Activities related to assessment, evaluation, diagnosis and assignment of level of care are provided, including transfer between facilities and/or treatment modalities, relapse assessment, and assignment to level of care;
Outpatient Opiate Treatment Services (OTS)	§7443(A)(1) Opiate Addiction Treatment programs detoxify chronic opiate addicts from opiates and opiate derivatives and maintain the chronic opiate addict utilizing a synthetic narcotic until the client can achieve recovery through a spectrum of counseling and other supportive/rehabilitative services.
Intensive Outpatient	§7441(A)(3) Organized and structured day/evening treatment sessions are offered for at least nine hours per week on three or more days per week.
Partial Hospitalization/ Day Rehabilitation	Services available on full or half day basis five day per week. (This level of service is not defined Chapter 74 regulations.)
D. Residential and Inpatient Treatment Services	
Community Residence (halfway house)	§7453. <i>Community-Based Programs</i> – Clients shall be capable of increasing life responsibilities or be additionally enrolled in primary treatment. Program provides transitional living, support and counseling, room and board, social and recreational activities and vocational opportunities; structured, drug-free environment to allow client to maintain or to improve upon the gains made during prior treatment or currently being made in treatment; and opportunities for the client to focus on re-socialization and to gradually resume responsibilities associated with independent living.

Long-term Residential	§7455. <i>Therapeutic Community (Long Term Residential)</i> – Program provides highly structured environments designed to treat those clients who have demonstrated a pattern of recidivism or a need for long term residential treatment; graduated levels of increasing responsibility, functional capacity, autonomy, privilege, and authority to promote emotional and interpersonal growth through experience or expectation, accountability, support, evaluation, and both favorable and unfavorable consequences for behavior.
Short-term Inpatient or Residential Treatment	§7451. <i>Inpatient Primary Treatment</i> – Clients may require psychiatric and/or medical or nursing care in addition to substance abuse services. Facility may utilize tiered system with client progression to Residential Treatment level of care, however, client must meet the functional status requirements and the facility must designate. Program provides continuous monitoring, observation, and treatment modalities using the twelve-step program design or other models by appropriate medical and psychiatric support personnel; at least 25 hours of structured treatment activities per week including counseling and educational activities as well as at least three additional hours must be organized social and/or recreational activities; and non-acute therapeutic regime including medical and psychiatric care, as needed. § 7449. <i>Primary Residential Treatment Programs</i> – Client shall be medically/mentally stable and/or without conditions that require daily or more frequent monitoring, medications or treatments. Program provides continuous monitoring, observation, and treatment modalities using the 12-step program design; and at least 25 hours of structured treatment activities per week including counseling and educational activities as well as at least three additional hours of organized social and/or recreational activities.
E. Housing and Recovery Support Services	
Shelter	Temporary shelter for persons homeless or unable to return home if offered to persons with substance use problems, whether or not the facility offers special programming for substance use problems.
Supportive Housing	Transitional (up to 2 years) or permanent supportive housing if offered to qualifying persons with substance use problems, whether or not the supportive services include special programming for substance use problems.
Mutual Self-help Groups	Self-help groups providing peer support, such as, Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous and Cocaine Anonymous.
Other Recovery Support Services	Peer coaching, literacy training, initial rent payment, furniture, clothes, HIV services
F. Treatment System Requirements	
Continuity of Care	Assure that a person in treatment receives services in the most effective, but least restrictive level of care based on progress in the course of treatment. This service may be provided in a treatment program (SS7401(A)(b, i) - Case Management and Referral Core Functions) or non-treatment setting. This service may be provided as part of Recovery Care Management services.
Coordination of Care	Coordinate a person’s substance use treatment with recovery services, health care (primary care), social services and other community resources. This service may be provided in a treatment program (SS7401(A)(b, i) - Case Management and Referral Core Functions) or non-treatment setting. This service may be provided as part of Recovery Care Management services.
Medication Supported Recovery	Capacity of programs to: coordinate care with prescribing practitioners; administer medications including psychiatric medications; administer medications to reduce craving or control non-acute withdrawal symptoms; administer maintenance medications as part of Opiate Treatment Services.
Dually Diagnosed Capacity	Capacity of treatment programs to serve client with mental health problems consistent with the American Society of Addiction Medicine’s Dually Diagnosed Capable (DDC) Dually Diagnosed Enhanced (DDE) program models

Criminal Justice Linkage	Service Agreements with Criminal Justice Agencies including protocols for sharing information with client consent
